Fundraising Team - organize/host a fundraiser, brainstorm new ideas, help raise money	
Vet Records/Adoption Paperwork: Work with intake records, vet records and adoption contracts, receive, scan, file, organize and send out to fosters and adopters when needed.	
Veterinarian Coordinator: communicate our expectations, help new vets get on board once they agree to work with us, troubleshoot billing errors, review bills for accuracy, review prices yearly.	
Veterinarian Scout- Search for discounted Emergency and regular vets.	
Grant Searchers: We have grant writers we need people to research grants that could qualify for.	
Sterilization Follow Up Team Member- Volunteer send out emails to remind when dogs are soon to be due and to ask for proof to be sent to us. Those that go past the deadline.	
 Host for Heart-worm Treatment: To have several dogs overnight from Saturday to Sunday night. A vet comes both days to treat HW dogs in small groups. Once a month or every other month. Around 28 hours nursing care.
